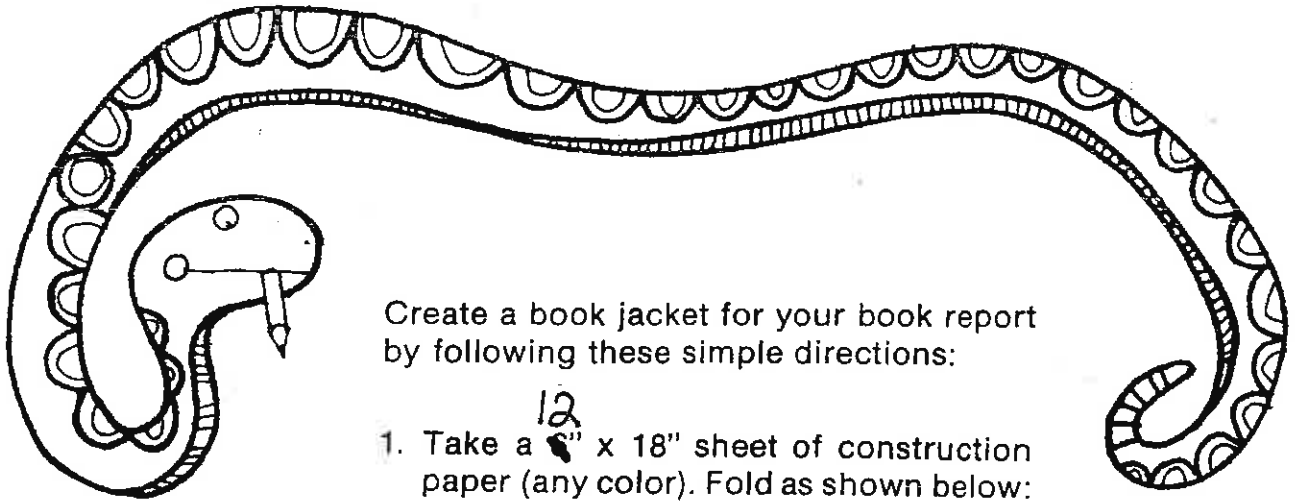
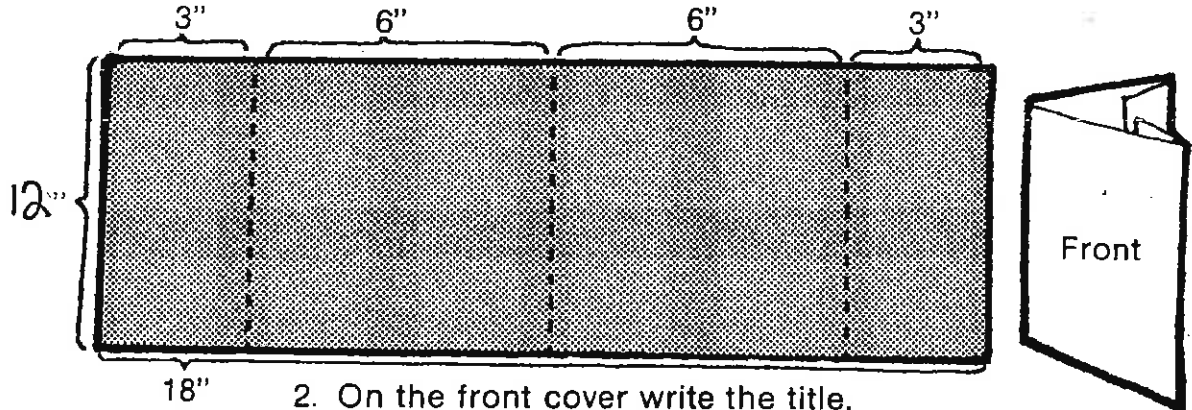


BOOK JACKET JAMBOREE

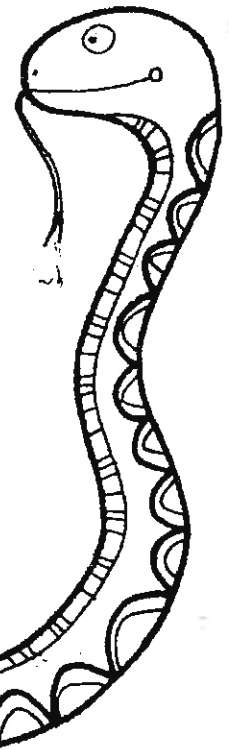
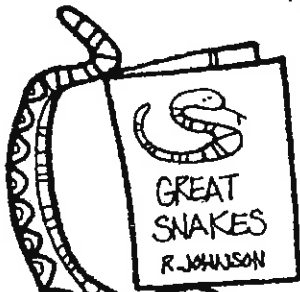


Create a book jacket for your book report by following these simple directions:

1. Take a ¹²12" x 18" sheet of construction paper (any color). Fold as shown below:



2. On the front cover write the title, author's name, and an illustration of the book.
3. On the back cover, write a summary of the events in the book. Write your own name in the bottom right-hand corner.
4. On the inside front flap, write a detailed description of the main character of the book.
5. On the inside back flap, write down the reasons why you liked the book. Try to sell others on reading this book.
